

Student Minor Demographics

Student Minor Demographics is designed to allow colleges and departments to track how many students have minors declared in their areas, and to examine demographic and academic variables of those students.

Previous reports have included minor information as a drillable field, but did not allow you to answer the question “How many students have declared a minor in General Business?” This report does.

Like all of our reports, this one allows you to decide which students you wish to look at and creates a pivot report in response to the choices you make on the initial screens. You can customize the initial pivot to meet your needs by adding fields from the “Drill Anywhere” list.

Note:

This report counts **Minors Declared**, which means that students need to have a minor entered on their MARX records at the time the cycle point runs in order to appear and be counted. We know that many students wait until they are close to graduation to declare minors, so if you want to improve the accuracy of your counts, advisors may wish to encourage students to declare minors early.
